- 1. **Welcome and Apologies –** apologies were noted from Cllr Alan Cope.
- Declaration of Interest There were no declarations of a personal or pecuniary interest.
- **3. Public Session** There were no members of the public present.

 - ii. Replacement of H19 the Clerk reported that the streetlamp was now working and that a claim had been lodged with the insurance company to recover the council's costs
 - iii. AED Marchamley the Clerk reported that E-On had advised the whole streetlight unit would need to be replaced to accommodate an isolation switch, at a cost of over £850. The group in Marchamley had been approached regarding this cost but were unable to pay. The Council agreed to ask Highline Electrical for a quotation before deciding on any further action. **Clerk to action**
